Sensory-Attachment Intervention (SAI) was developed by Eadaoin Bhreathnach, in recognition that insecurely attached children respond differently to sensation. She observed how certain sensations can be used to regulate insecure avoidant and insecure resistant children. SAI focuses on; developing the child's capacity to self regulate, co-regulate, and on parent child engagement. This innovative approach emerged from clinically integrating and adapting the theories of Sensory Integration, Attachment Classification and Symbolic Play.
