This course provides an introduction to Integrative Dyadic Psychotherapy.

Dyadic Developmental Psychotherapy (DDP) is a treatment approach to trauma, loss, and/or other dysregulating experiences, that is based on principles derived from attachment theory and research. It is a family-centred treatment, with the child's attachment figures actively involved.

The course is suitable for qualified social workers and therapists who work with children who have been traumatised and have attachment difficulties, and are living in adoptive or foster families.
